

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP[®]) CREDIT for 2007 Exams

AP exams are passed by earning a score of 3, 4 or 5; credit earned is the same for all passing scores, unless otherwise noted. Passed exams earn a Credit (CR) grade and are not calculated in the GPA. A maximum of nine (9) quarter units are earned; fewer units are earned when exam content is duplicated (see notes). When credit and units are earned for a specific course(s), the excess unit(s) count as electives. Degree credit applied may vary depending on the student's major, General Education (GE) requirements, catalog, exam year, AP score and CSU policy. Credit extension is reviewed annually and is adjusted, when the exam content and/or Cal Poly courses change. Exam results must be sent to Cal Poly electronically from College Board/AP[®] Programs.

NOTE: To determine credit for combined exams only, use the AP matrix for the year of the last exam taken. For example, if one English exam is taken in 2006 and one in 2007, we will use the AP Credit for 2007 Exams.
