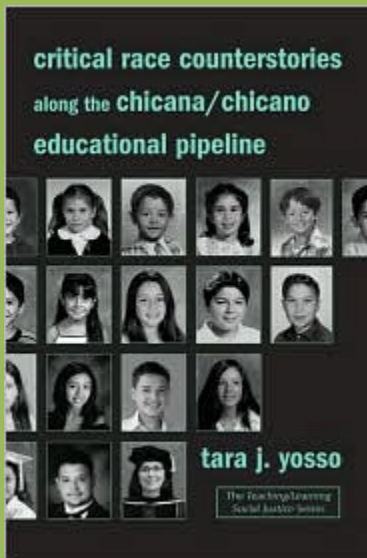

Dr. Tara J. Yosso is an Associate Professor in the Department of Chicana and Chicano Studies at the University of California, Santa Barbara. Yosso's teaching and research apply the frameworks of critical race theory and critical media literacy to examine educational access and equity, emphasizing the community cultural wealth Students of Color bring to school.

The American Educational Studies Association selected Yosso's book *Critical Race Counterstories Along the Chicana/Chicano Educational Pipeline*, (Routledge) for the 2008 Critics' Choice Book Award. Her research is also published in journals such as *Race Ethnicity and Education*, *Qualitative Inquiry*, and the *Journal of Popular Film and Television*. Dr. Yosso's current work focuses on racial and gender microaggressions, campus racial climate, and film portrayals of Latina/o high school students.
